

The Cambridge Out of Hours GP service has moved

The Cambridge Out of Hours GP service is now located at the Urgent Treatment Centre at Addenbrooke's Hospital.

How does the Out Of Hours GP service work?

The Cambridge Out of Hours GP service does not offer walk-in appointments. **To contact the service you will need to call NHS 111.**

The NHS 111 team will assess your condition over the phone and if they think you need to be seen by a health professional, they will refer you to the Out of Hours GP service.

The Out Of Hours GP service provides advice, information and treatment for patients who become unwell when their own GP surgery is closed. It is available between 6.30pm to 8.00am on weekdays and 24 hours at weekends and on bank holidays.

Access/parking for the Urgent Treatment Centre at Addenbrooke's

The Urgent Treatment Centre is located in Clinic 9 which is a short walk from the A&E department.

Patients and visitors arriving by car need to park in Car Park 1. Parking costs a set fee of £3.60. There are also designated disabled bays outside the Urgent Treatment Centre.
